
VARDEMAN FAMILY HISTORY<> <> JOHN VARDEMAN, SR. with his family emigrated to AMERICA from <> <> SWEDEN and settled in SOUTH CAROLINA in about 1725, and there died, as his descendents reported, at the extreme age of 125 years. JOHN <> <> VARDEMAN, SR. was a member of the LUTHERAN CHURCH in his native <> country of SWEDEN, and united with the PROTESTANT ESPISCOPAL CHURCH<> in SOUTH CAROLINA, and was esteemed for his piety and moral worth. <> <> <> <> JOHN VARDEMAN, JR.; son of JOHN VARDEMAN, SR., was seven years <> <> old when he came with his father from SWEDEN, but recollected many
<> incidents of his native country. While living in SOUTH CAROLINA <> <> <> JOHN VARDEMAN, JR. married ELIZABETH MORGAN, who was a native of <> <> WALES, & soon after moved and settled in BEDFORD COUNTY, VIRGINIA, <> <> on the eastern slope of the BLUE RIDGE, and not far from the <> <> celebrated PEAKS OF OTTER. While residents here, JOHN VARDEMAN, JR. <> & his wife ELIZABETH, professed religion in a time of persecution, <> <> & became members of the BAPTIST CHURCH, and ever after maintained <> <> <> a devout christian to extreme old age. <> <> About 1767 JOHN VARDEMAN, JR. and his young family moved to the <> <> <> settlements on NEW RIVER and in 1777 pushed still farther into the <> <> south western corner of VIRGINIA, on the CLINCH RIVER. It was then <> <> a time of trouble with the southern and western indians, and JOHN <> <> VARDEMAN JR., & his family entered the neighboring FORT at SHADRACH<> <> WHITE'S residence, on the MAIDEN SPRING FORK of the CLINCH RIVER, <> <> () in what is now known as RUSSELL COUNTY. Among the families who <> forted at WHITE'S were the Messrs. SKAGGS, JAMES, & RICHARDS, all <> <> <> noted hunters and explorers in the southwest at an early date. <> <> In the autumn of 1779 JOHN VARDEMAN, JR., with a number of other <> <> <> emigrants, moved to the wilds of KENTUCKY, and settled near CRAB <> <> <> ORCHARD, in LINCOLN COUNTY. JOHN VARDEMAN, JR. and his sons were <> compelled by their position to take part in the early wars of <> <> KENTUCKY. There was no encroachment on indian claims in their <> <> frontier occupancy. The country in part was claimed originally by <> <> the CHEROKEE'S, and in part by the conquest of six nations. All <> <> <> parties had ceded their claims to the BRITISH GOVERNMENT and to <>> VIRGINIA, from the KANAWHA on the east to the TENNESSEE RIVER on <> <> <> the southwest, previous to its occupancy by any white families. <> <> <> The invaders were the SHAWNEES and other indians north of the <> <> <> OHIO RIVER, who had not even a traditionary claim to any part of KENTUCKY. The SHAWNEES had passed through the country in their <> migration from the southeast, below the JAMES RIVER, and gave the <> <> name "KAN-TUC-KEE", which in their dialect means HEAD-OF THE RIVER,<>> <> to the mountain stream. The notion propagated that "KAN-TUC-KEE' <> <> <> meant "DARK AND BLOODY GROUND" is sheer fiction. <> <> JOHN VARDEMAN, JR. was now too far advanced in life to go on <> <> <> campaigns, as he had done at an earlier period, but he could stand <> <> guard at the fort and hunt game in the woods. His four eldest sons,<> <> WILLIAM, JOHN (III), AMAZIAH, and MORGAN VARDEMAN, were frequently <>

<> engaged in defending the country from Indian assaults.







A SHORT BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH OF THE LIVES OF THOMAS AND WILLIAM VARDEMAN

Arranged by

Bonnie Vardeman Consway, Daughter of Thomas Vardeman

It is meet that we, who gather here today, render this tribute of praise and remembrance to those who have gone before. We are the children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, nieces, and nephews of two brothers-Thomas and William Vardeman.

We meet today partly to honor Jeremiah Vardeman, fourth son of Thomas Vardeman, who with his wife has come from Portland, Oregon to visit us-partly because some of us have passed our three score years and ten, and time may be short when we can meet with each other.

My father, Thomas Vardeman was born in Shelby County, Kentucky, October 2, 1838, and four years later on the same day of the same month my uncle William was born. They were children of a large family, reared in fear and admonition of the Lord. They became Baptist ministers as did also Abraham, a younger brother of theirs.

They grew to manhood in the State of Hentnoky, and both saw service as Union soldiers in the Civil War. By father enlisted October 14, 1861—was discharged because of a bullet wound, December 31, 1864, and then rendered eleven additional months of hospital service. I do not know in what year of the war my uncle enlisted. He served more than a year.

They were married while comparatively young men. Uncle Will married Sallie Scarce, who became our doar Aunt Sallie and the mother of his four girls. A few years later, December 8, 1866, father married Cornelia Ferwick Gaines, who became our precious mother. There they farmed, raising various grains, livestock, and tobacco; mostly tobacco.

Yielding to the general unrest and spirit of progress, Uncle Will moved his family to Indiana about the year 1876. He farmed there for awhile, and in the year 1878 came to Missouri, bought a small farm on the Marshall-Mismi road and sent for his wife and four girls the same fall. They came on the river by boat to Mismi where Uncle Will met them in a farm wagon. They stayed over night at a crude hotel in Mismi experiencing great discomfort, and the next day proceeded on their journey by wagon to their new home.

About four years later on the fourteenth day of March, 1882, my father with my mother, six brothers and one sister, his family at that time, arrived in Marshall, Uncle Will met them in a farm

vagon, drawn by four mules, and they drove out on what is now North Cdell Avenue over a stumpy road through muddy Salt Fork bottoms where they stuck once, to be helped out by Kesars. Bob and Henry Irvine-on to my uncle's farm, north and west of Marshall. He had made a change of homes since coming to Missouri.

They found my aunt and cousins waiting for them in semi-darkness; their only light, a lantern and tallow candles. They had broken their lamp flues that morning in the excitement of getting ready for their Uncle Ton, Aunt Hellie, and the children.

Ey uncle and father were almost pioneers. The Indians were gone when they came to Missouri, but flocks of wild turkeys were in the woods—and there were plenty of woods—hazel brush and uncleared land. Hazel nuts, hickory nuts, and acords were plentiful; also wild grapes, wild plums, blackberries, stremberries, and all kinds of wild game.

With the exception of one year my father and family lived on various farms north of Marshall until the year 1908. We had increased to eleven children of which I was the first "Puke." We younger members were all girls, so that we were then as we are today, aix brothers and five sisters.

In that year 1908, my father bought a small farm near Helson, Missouri, and moved my mother and unmarried children. He made his home there until the fall of 1919, when he sold the farm and bought property in Marshall, continuing to live there the remainder of his life.

Uncle Will lived north of Marshall until the year 1920, when he too made Marshall his home, living there until his death.

The two brothers and their families were, for many years, the only relatives in Missouri, and they were always friendly and had great regard for each other. One cousin says, "There was no greater pleasure in our childhood than going to see the cousins and having them come to visit us."

I feel sure all eleven of us can reiterate that statement. Going to Uncle Will's when a child, eating Aunt Sallie's salt rising broad, yellow butter, and jam, watching her rock serenely and receiving notice from the cousins was my realization of earthly heaven. My father and my uncle lived to see many marvels of science. They saw the laying of almost the first, perhaps the first railroad in Kentucky and an early one here.

One of the cousins remarked that the rear of the early trains filled her childish heart with more terror than thoughts of the Devil. Electric lighting, the auto, the airplanes were in use before their deaths. The radio with ear phones was just coming in at the time of their passing. Home of these things moved their faith in God-rather heightened their faith in Him. Did not God make man in his own image?

My father did itinerant missionary work, but held no regular pastorate in Missouri. A cousin says, "The brothers loved the Bible. Their eyes shone with joy as they discussed the great truths it contains, and in passing they pillowed their heads on its promises."

Uncle Will was a great worker for the Lord, serving four rural churches of Saline County for years. Two of them, Salem and PinOak, were organized through his efforts, and the influence of his life and work will live forever. It was my privilege to attend a service in one of his churches a few years ago, and I could seem to feel his spirit present.

My father died in the fall of 1923, at the age of 85 and was laid to rest beside my mother who preceded him two years.

Uncle Will died two years later, October 1925, at the age of 83 years. Pointing upward his last words were "Monmie" (his name for my aunt), "Heaven."

Aunt Sallie lived until October 1928 when she, too, passed on and was laid beside my uncle in Ridge Park. The brothers and their wives lie close together in death.

Of my father's immediate family all eleven children are living. Of my uncle's immediate family three daughters yet live, one widowed and two unmarried. His oldest daughter Hrs. Henry Harvey died last fall. She left a fine family of six children.

Among the brothers' numerous descendants are to be found; a doctor, a preacher, a school teacher, a policeman, and many worthy followers of various occupations.

Yes, their work on earth is over, Only we who yet remain, Hold the banner they have left us, May we keep it free from stain.

Side by side in Ridge Park lying Side by side and head to head We can hear our Savior saying, "Only aleeping, they're not dead."

When, on Ressurrection morning They, the trumpet call obey, There will be a glad reunion Through God's one unending day.


Visitation will be from 7:30 to 8:30 p.m. Wednesday in the Campbell-Lewis Funeral Home.

Someone said that melancholy is the pleasure of being sad. Sometimes I sigh, and sometimes I smile, but I keep each olden, golden while, — All to myself. Miss Elizabeth Vardeman, last of a family of 11 children, thinks she has kept some golden whiles all to herself a little too long. Now she feels others might find this story interesting.

There were six boys and five girls in the family of Reverend and Mrs. J. T. Vardeman, Baptist minister. Sole survivor Elizabeth was born at Stanhope (out by the Alva Gauldin settlement) November 5, 1887, and attended the Robert Lee School north of Marshall.

Experiences

Miss Vardeman recalls experiences had while employed by E. M. Wright's dry goods store for some 25 years. Later she worked for the Missouri Valley department store for about 12 years. But she feels a better story is the one involving some old papers and documents processed in the days when land was sold as so-many poles from the middle of the large rock in the creek to the apple tree to the west; then so many poles to the black jack tree northward.

What's a pole? A pole is a rod. What's a rod? A rod is 16½ feet in length. You mean you had a college education and didn't know about measuring by poles? Don't feel

too badly. I didn't know it either.

Indentures or contracts were written (usually) in clear Spencerian script back in the 17th and 18th century. Papers discolor with age and wear at the folds. The old indenture covering the sale of some Kentucky land is given as accurately as possible under the circumstances, but where it cannot be deciphered, I will insert an ellipsis (. . .) . Quote —

This indenture made this 18th Febuary (sic) in the year of our Lord 1867 between Mrs. Elizabeth Redding of the County of Shelby and State of Kentucky of the first, and John T. Vardiman of the County and State aforesaid of the second part witnesseth;

That the party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, One Thousand on or before the 1st of September next, the balance, One Thousand 1st of September 1863, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do convey to the said party of the second all that track or parcil of land situated and being in the County and State aforesaid and bounded as follows to wit, beginging at a stone corner to Peter Vardiman thence S 891/2 E 86 poles to two beeches corner to said Vardiman, thence S 1/4 E 431/2 poles to a stone in the middle of a Branch corner to said Vardiman and in Henry Bohannons line. Thence down the branch (creek?) and with

it meanders N 821/4 E50 poles N 63 E 42 poles S 791/2 E 23 1/2 poles to three sycamores at the mouth of the branch, on the bank of the Indianfork of Benson (Creek?) on the west side of the creek corner to Henry Bohannons. Thence N 121/2 W 32 poles to a poplar on the east side of the Creek. Thence up the middle of the creek and with it meanders N37 W 371/2 poles, N 201/4 W 26 poles N 31/2 E 177 poles to a stone in the middle of the creek, N 201/4 W 26 poles, N 3½ E 30 poles N 7½ W 21.2 poles to a stone in the middle of the creek, thence S 871/4 W 26.9 poles to a beech. Thence S 1 W 12 to a beech thence S 11/2 E - poles to Peter Vardiman's corner, thence up the branch S69 W 39 poles to a stake near a beech. Thence S 1 W 12 poles to a beech, Thence corner to Peter Vardiman. Thence S 81½ W 37 poles to a stone near a drain corner to Vardiman thence N 70 W 19 poles to an apple tree corner to Vardiman. Thence S 581/2 W 48 poles to a stone in the Spring branch corner to Vardiman, thence S 26 E 17 poles to beginning containing 113 acres one quarter and 11

The document is signed "Elizabeth Redding" and has

a hand - cancelled United States \$2 conveyance internal revenue stamp attached to make it real legal. Sorry that took so long but thought you'd be interested in the way descriptions were made of properties in that day. We left off the final couple of paragraphs.

Items Sold

Later on some investigation must have been made of property in Saline County near Fairville, or in Fairville, and apparently J. T. Vardiman planned to move this way since he held a sale February 28, 1882. Not all of the items will be listed, but a few of the items sold, according to the sale clerk's recording, involved a sausage mill for 40 cents; a coffee mill for 10 cents.

A set of plates for 40 cents; a dish, 50 cents; a small bed sted, \$1.85; a shotgun, \$3.10; a bed sted, \$3.55; another for \$4.10; a sacking chair, 65 cents; a coffee pot, 5 cents; Washboard, 20 cents; a stove, \$2.60; 15 pounds of lard, 25 cents; they gave the lard can away free; three barrels, 5 cents; a table, \$7; two bed steds, \$3.55 and \$4.10; a saddle, \$1.60; a cradle, 55 cents; scythe and cradle, \$1.70; axe and wedge, 50 cents; two hoes, \$1.50; one crosscut saw, \$3.75; one white cow, \$36.25 on a note; one roan cow, \$37; one gray horse, \$57.50; one gray mare, \$86.50.

One R. plow, \$1; one double shovel, \$2.45: doubletree and single, 10 cents; one single tree, 5 cents; one set harness, \$6.90; one wagon, \$32; six shoats, \$4.10; one bucket, 15 cents; one tub, 40 cents.

A John T. Vardiman letter datelined Oct. the 2nd, 1882, Fairville, Saline County, Mo., written to Mr. Rogert Rogers (apparently never mailed) he says, quote —

Dear Sir: According to promise I will pen you a few lines - We are all well at this time, but Jerry who has the chills, we have all had them some but Hiram though they have not hurt us much yet. Crops of all kind are good in this county. I think I have 60 bushels of corn to the acre which is worth 35 cents per bushel in field. Cattle and hogs are about as high in price as they are in Ky. Hogs 7 & 8 cents; cattle 3 to 5. Land is worth from \$20 to sixty per acre. You can buy improved land here at \$40 per acre that will raise as much corn wheat oats rye hemp and tobacco as any land in Shelby County, Ky.

But it will not grow without work as perhaps you have often heard it would. I am living about eight miles from Marshall, the County Seat of this county. But I can drive to Marshall and back as quick as I could go from where I lived in Ky., to Bagdad and back.

I have been doing most all kinds of work since I laid my crop by. Have had employment all the time at good wages. I am going to overseeing the making of roads tomorrow at \$32 per month. Will, I expect, be at this until cold

weather. About as to how I like the county, will say that I expect to make Mo. my home. As to society, it is not like that in Ky., but as I get better acquainted I like the people better. Now I would not advise anybody to move here until they had come and seen the County for themselves. Though I would say this to you - if you could sell your farm for \$30 per acre you would do well to do it and buy land here at \$40 per acre. Land is advancing here in price fast, but I have not space to write anymore this time. Nellie and children all send love to Beatie and the children. Give my love to all








KEEPS HOUSE; TENDS GARDENS

Advancing Years Slow, But Do Not Stop Busy Routine Of Woman, 92

Even at the age of 92 years, with failing eyesight and poor hearing and not quite as able did a year ago, Mrs. John P. Vardiman still never ceases to amaze her many friends and neighbors with her ability to keep house and perform numerous daily tasks for herself.

Mrs. Vardiman, who was 92 years old last Thursday, (February 27), has lived alone for nine years at 723 North Jefferson Street

A lover of the outdoors, Mrs. Vardiman could be found last to move about as easily as she summer in her vegetable garden and she also manages to keep pretty blooming flowers around her home. But this summer, she feels she may take it easieralthough her neighbors believe they will still see her outside on the bright, sunshiny days doing those things which have provided Mrs. Vardiman with a vouthful, ambitious spirit—far belying a person of her advanced

As they have in recent years, relatives and friends gathered at the Vardiman home for her birthday last week. Ten persons were present to help the kindly lady, who has such a pleasing personality, celebrate her 92nd birthday. It was a surprise to her—but way down deep, those present felt she was hoping someone would come. Since living alone, she confesses to getting extremely lonely with each passing day. Doing her own work in spite of the infirmities of age undoubtedly help her to pass the hours and she does remain in telephone touch each morning with several relatives and friends who are concerned with her well-being on a daily

Since her eyesight is not as good as it once was even in later years, Mrs. Vardiman enjoyed showing her friends the large number of cards and letters she had received in commemoration of her birthday and having them read to her. Much of the afternoon was spent in pleasant conversation and the guests took many snapshots of the honoree.

The prettily decorated birthday cake was baked by Mrs. Ann Broyles, a neighbor living just across the street from Mrs. Vardiman.

Neopolitan ice cream was served with the cake which on this occasion also served to honor birthdays of two other persons present—Miss Katherine Harvey and Mrs. Stephen Kersten, neighbors whose birthdays also came on February 27 along with Mrs. Vardiman.

In addition to the three persons whose birthdays were observed and Mrs. Broyles, those present were Mrs. Walter Thomas, Mrs. Henry Nave, Mrs.

Maude Booker, Mrs. William Spencer, Mrs. Mary Johnson, and the Misses Elizabeth and Frances Vardiman, sisters-in-law of Mrs. Vardiman.

A member of the Daily Democrat-News staff had the pleasure of visiting with Mrs. Vardiman at her home last Saturday morning. Also present to assist in the interview were Mrs. Thomas and Mrs. Nave. Mrs. Thomas resides to the west of the Vardiman home and she keeps a daily tab on the elderly lady by having her call each morning at about 9 o'clock. Mrs.

Nave has maintained a warm acquaintanceship with Mrs. Vardiman for many years.

It was easy for the reporterphotographer chatting with her last Saturday, to detect the pride which Mrs. Vardiman had in wanting to show her home which certainly has an immaculate glow of cleanliness and neatness. She really beamed when she told how she accomplished it herself—in spite of her failing eyesight.

Much on display in what-not shelves in the living room, dining room, bed room and kitchen were numerous sets of salt and pepper shakers which Mrs. Vardiman had collected over quite a lengthy period of time. She admits to not having necessarily started the collection herself-but when relatives and friends persisted in giving her some of the shakers as souvenirs from time to time, she managed to display them, and consequently the collection caught on and grew and grew.

With the eleven new sets received on her most recent birthday, Mrs. Vardiman now has 409 pairs—and somehow one gathers from the way she hands out that information that her count is most accurate. She now has so many salt and pepper shakers that some had to be boxed up and put in drawers for lack of shelving. And what's more, she can virtually relate from whom each salt and pepper shaker was received—so marvelous is her memory.

Born in 1872 in the state of Illinois, Mrs. Vardiman was one of five children of the marriage of Ervin Smith to Mary Jane Van Horn. Mrs. Vardiman explains that her mother married twice and to twin brothers. Her first husband, Philander Smith, (Mrs. Vardiman's uncle), starved to death in Libby Prison in Pennsylvania. Mary Jane Smith later married Philander's brother, Ervin, who fought as a Union soldier in the Civil War.

Mrs. Vardiman has only one brother still living. He is Alpheus Edmund Smith, whom she says was 90 years old last May and has been a patient for 9 years in a hospital in the state of Washington. Her eldest sister was named Orpha, and her oldest brother was called Francis or Frank. Her youngest sister, Callie, married a brother of Mrs. Vardiman's husband — a man named Dick Vardiman and they lived for many years in the Nelson community.

Mrs. Vardiman recalls leaving Illinois with her parents when she was about 4 years old; the Smiths coming at that time to Missouri and settling in the Herndon community, and it was there she was to meet and later marry John P. Vardiman.

They were married 69 years

ago last Christmas Day by the late Rev. George Stroud, a Baptist minister who passed away some 15 years ago. Mr. and Mrs. Vardiman celebrated their Golden Wedding Anniversary just prior to her husband's death 19 years ago. His passing away came just a couple of years after the couple had moved to the present house on North Jefferson Street.

For some 42 years Mr. and Mrs. Vardiman had resided on a farm north of Marshall and it was there they reared their three sons and all three were to marry while still living at that place. The farm is now known as the Clarence Samson place.

The Vardiman sons are Edmund, who lives in Kansas City, Kans., and John W., who resides at Mount Olive, about 3 miles south of Marshall. The other son, Charles, died 2 years ago of a heart attack at the age of 66 in his home in Independence, Mo.

John's children are John William (Billy) Vardiman, 20, who is now engaged in farm work at the family place; Charles Edmund (Chuck) Vardiman, a sophomore at Marshall High School; and Marietta Mae, a 5th grader at R-12 School.

True to all grandmothers—Mrs. Vardiman is extremely proud of her grandchildren and says all three are a tremendous help to their parents, especially since Mrs. John W. Vardiman has only recently returned from a 9-week period as a patient at Fitzgibbon Hospital and anticipates additional surgery in a couple of months.

Mrs. Vardiman also speaks highly of the Rev. and Mrs. Glenn Jones, now residents of the state of South Dakota but who still keep in contact with her through frequent correspondence and occasional visits during summertime vacations.

Mrs. Vardiman said the Rev. Mr. Jones was formerly the minister at the Fairville Baptist Church. He left the pastorate there to answer a call at a church in Liberty, Mo., some 7 years ago. Even while he was in

Liberty, the Rev. Mr. Jones remained in constant contact with Mrs. Vardiman, whom he affectionately referred to as his "adopted mother."

She smilingly recounts that the Rev. Mr. and Mrs. Jones have personally given her 22 of her favored salt and pepper shakers and she looks forward to their next vacation visit here.

For the first ten years or so after her husband's death, Mrs. Vardiman had another lady, Ethel Hippel, residing with her but the latter left 9 years ago to live in Jacksonville, Ill.

What will the year 1964 bring for Mrs. Vardiman? She believes perhaps a much slower pace — possibly less household

chores, less gardening, and certainly no more crocheting of rugs—and maybe even a lessening in the care of household plants and her roses, mums, and dahlias outside.

She suffered a fall inside the house recently and has a sore arm as a result of it and this has caused her greater hardship in getting about and caring for her own needs. As for the worldly events, she tries to get these daily by radio since her eyes do not permit her to read anymore.

But with all these infirmities, somehow one gets the impression that life for this 92-year-old lady is not half-bad and the visitors often come away from her home with lifted spirits when they really went there to help Mrs. Vardiman gain a brighter outlook. But such is the charm and radiation that this lady generates and it has characterized her entire life, those who know her best contend.


